What we do!

We offer an exciting, stimulating, age appropriate and well laid out environment. We have space for calm times, for fun, for excitement, for chatter, for following a child's interests, for looking after the whole family and for helping where extra support is needed. We set up wonderful activities that are carefully planned, changed weekly and often revisited to consolidate learning.

We have a mixture of free flow and circle time and adult led and free play for the children - we believe that Cullompton Pre School offers every child the chances to develop the skills they need in life.

Why we do it

We love working with children!

The staff here are warm, nurturing, caring and enjoy building up good relationships with the whole family. We know that sometimes children are challenging, that sometimes they are not quite developing in line with their age and that sometimes they learn in different ways and that some children have complex and additional needs.

We know how to get help for your whole family.

We take the time to get to know individual children and we love planning for each child. Talking about them during our key worker meetings is a favourite time for our staff – talking over progress and development and sharing ideas;

Engaging families makes a difference

A new study finds that children who attend a preschool will do better and are likely to go on and do A-levels. A child with a good home learning environment will also do well but a deprived child will benefit from attending pre-school.

How we do it

We observe how children learn, what they like to do, their favourite activities and we talk about all of the children as a whole team. We plan for individuals, we create nurture groups to help with confidence, making friends, sharing, turn taking, literacy, maths and lots of other areas.

We support the whole family and share next steps.
